NOTICE OF RACE

Florida Multihull Regatta & Monohulls under 22 feet
(One Design Fleets, including the
O'Day Daysailer Florida State Championship)

November 17 & 18, 2007

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 The organizing authority is the Clearwater Community Sailing Association (CCSA). The event will be held at the Clearwater Community Sailing Center (CCSC), 1001 Gulf Boulevard, Clearwater FL 33767.
- 1.3 The regatta is designated Category C in accordance with RRS Appendix 1, ISAF Regulation 20.

2 Language

The official language for this regatta will be English.

3 Eligibility & Entry

- 3.1 Entries are invited from any boats that have been assigned a US Sailing Portsmouth Handicap rating or who will sail in a one-design fleet. Boats may enter by completing registration with the organizing authority.
- 3.2 Boats will be grouped into fleets for scoring purposes. Any group of five one-design boats will constitute a fleet; other boats will sail in the open Portsmouth fleet.

4 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race (see RRS 4). Each competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

5 Schedule of Events

1100 Skippers Meeting
1200 First Warning Signal, races to follow
Dinner served after racing
 - Sunday, November 18**
0900 Skippers Meeting
1000 First Warning Signal, races to follow
Awards to follow ASAP after last race
- 5.2 No race shall start after 1400 on Sunday.
 - 5.3 Seven (7) races are scheduled, of which a minimum of one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

6 Registration

Competitors may register by completing the regatta registration form and delivering it with the appropriate fees to: Clearwater Community Sailing Center, 1001 Gulf Blvd, Clearwater FL 33767.

7 Fees

7.1 Required Fees The entry fee is \$45 for single-handed boats and \$65 for double-handed boats. Entry fee for Opti's is \$30. There is a \$20 late fee for registrations received after November 11, 2007. (Checks should be made payable to the Clearwater Community Sailing Center):

7.2 The entry fee includes: collared polo shirt(s), Friday night and Saturday after race beer, soft drinks and refreshments, Saturday night dinner.

8 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at the time of registration.

9 Courses & Racing Area

9.1 The race committee will select courses based on conditions for the competing classes.

9.2 The racing area will be in Clearwater Bay to the SE of the Community Sailing Center and for Multihulls in the Gulf of Mexico in front of the Sheraton Hotel on Sand Key.

10 Scoring

The Low Point scoring system, RRS A2 will apply, except that if fewer than 5 races are completed, all races shall be included in the boats total score.
