IMPORTANT NEW INFORMATION **FOR COACH AND PARENT BOATS**

Lowdermilk Park:

All cars associated with the regatta should display a parking pass on the front dash. Cars failing to display the parking pass may be subject to ticketing by the City of Naples Police Department. Parking passes are available at the registration tent. Park rules prohibit motor homes, overnight parking, camping, alcohol and glass containers.

Special arrangements have been made for off-site coach and spectator boat trailer parking. Boat and trailer parking in the general parking lot at Lowdermilk is prohibited and violators will be subject to ticketing.

Directions From Lowdermilk Park to Boat Ramp:

Leaving Lowdermilk Park, turn right (south) on Gulfshore Blvd. and continue until 10th Avenue South. Turn left (east) on 10th Avenue South and continue to the traffic signal on 9th Street. Turn right (south) on 9th Street. The City of Naples boat ramp, "The Landings" is 50 yards ahead on your left. While traveling through Naples Bay and Gordon Pass, remember to observe all "No Wake" signs.

Directions from Boat Ramp to Trailer Parking Lot

Leaving the boat ramp, turn right (north) on 9th Street and proceed 100 feet to 10th Avenue South (traffic signal). Turn right (east) on 10th Avenue South and continue one block to the stop sign. Turn left (north) on 10th Street and continue through two traffic signals. When you pass through the second traffic signal, continue past the Naples Depot historic building and turn right at 3rd Avenue South into the large vacant site. Turn left immediately and park your trailer in the paved parking lot. Please stay off of the grass (sprinkler heads) and remove all trash from this site. The owner kindly donates this site and we appreciate his support of youth sailing.

Directions from Trailer Parking Back to Lowdermilk Park

When you leave the lot, cross 9th Street and travel west on 3rd Avenue South. Cross US 41 and continue driving west to Gulf Shore Blvd. Turn right (north) on Gulf Shore Blvd. and proceed back to Lowdermilk Park.

IMPORTANT!!

Dockage on Saturday Night:

We no longer have permission to use the docks at Beacon House. Do not use these docks.

Coach Boats: Coach boats may tie up at the NCSC aluminum docks in Naples Bay adjacent to the city boat ramps. Due to limited space only coach boat will be allowed to use this dock. Coaches must register their boats at the registration tent Saturday morning. Coaches will be provided identification to display on their boat to indicate that they have permission to use the NCSC dock. No other boats may tie up at the floating aluminum docks. The adjacent wood docks are City property and overnight dockage is prohibited. **DO NOT USE THESE DOCKS OVERNIGHT.**

Parent / Support Boats: Unfortunately, due to limited space, all parent and support boat must return the City ramp and be hauled-out at the end of the day Saturday. Boats may be kept overnight in the Trailer Parking Lot described above.
